

The Surface Right Board has considered the definition of a ‘flow line’ in several cases involving pipeline components and found the following types of pipelines to be flow lines:

A segment of pipeline transporting natural gas from a well head.	Order 1745-1
A segment to transport produced water separated from the natural gas at a well site.	Order 1745-1
A fuel line transporting fuel gas from a facility to a well head.	Order 1745-1
A line to transport produced gas from a well site.	Order 1823-1
A hydraulic fracturing water supply line.	Order 1823-1
A hydraulic fracturing water return line.	Order 1823-1
A 16 inch line to transport produced gas from a well site.	Order 1837-1
A hydraulic fracturing water supply line also licenced for bi-directional use to carry natural gas from a well site.	Order 1837-1
A line connecting a well head to a scrubbing, processing or storage facility that is not owned by the same entity that operates the well head or the facility.	Order 1694-3
A line connecting a compressor station where raw natural gas is not processed into marketable gas to a gas plant where raw natural gas is processed into marketable gas.	Order 1852/1853-1
